### ALL PLAYERS SHOULD READ OUR GENERAL RULES POSTED OUTSIDE THE PRO SHOP AND FOLLOW THEM FOR THE BENEFIT OF ALL

#### LOCAL RULES:

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)**
  - Beyond any fence or ditch identifying the boundary of the course
  - Beyond any white posts marking out of bounds
2. **WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)**
  - Water hazards are identified by yellow stakes on the 2nd & 4th holes
3. **LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)**
  - Lateral water hazards are identified by red stakes, on the 1st hole
4. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR (G.U.R)**
  - Play is prohibited from areas of 'Ground Under Repair'. If a ball lies in an area so marked or if such an area interferes with the players stance or the area of his/her intended swing, the player must take relief in accordance with Rule 25-1
5. **FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS**
  - All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty as follows: If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole (b) avoids such interference and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.
6. **OVER HEAD CABLES (Rule 20-5)**
  - If a ball strikes an overhead power line the stroke must be cancelled and replayed without penalty
7. **STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 24-1)**
  - Stones in bunkers are classed as moveable obstructions
8. **PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES**
  - MATCHPLAY – Loss of hole
  - STROKEPLAY – Two stroke penalty

Golf is played in accordance with the

'Rules and Etiquettes' of 'The Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews'

#### LOCAL ETIQUETTES:

9. **SAFETY**
    - Players should always ensure that no one is close by or in a position to be hit by a club or ball when making their swing
    - Players should not play until the group in front are out of range
    - Players should be aware of greens staff and other players on the course at all times
    - For their own safety, players must leave the 3rd green via the left hand side.
    - Players must wait for passing traffic to be out of range before playing from the 9th tee.
  10. **PACE OF PLAY**
    - Players should keep up with the group ahead not just in front of the group behind, if your pace is slower than that of the group behind stand aside and wave them through
  11. **CARE OF THE COURSE**
    - Replace all divots
    - Repair all pitchmarks
    - Rake bunkers after use
    - Keep all trolleys off greens and approaches to the green
    - Place all litter in the bins provided
    - All rakes must be left in bunkers
    - Please be aware of signage denoting the strict route of the course. All players must follow the designated route to ensure their own welfare.
  12. **ORDER OF PLAY**
    - Players teeing off the 6th tee have priority over those teeing off the 1st tee to maintain the pace of play.
    - All players are required to leave the course by the bridge adjacent to the practise putting green and if playing 18 holes re-enter the course via the bridge by the 1st/10th Tee.
